1. Homeowners Dues & Payment Information:

➤ Lake View Lots - \$726 Annually

Paid semi-annually: \$363 in January and \$363 in July

➤ Non-Lake View Lots - \$363 Annually

Paid semi-annually: \$181.50 in January and \$181.50 in July

- Association dues are charged semi-annually and are due on January 1st and July 1st each year. Homeowners will receive an invoice each December for their January 1st dues and again in June for their July 1st dues.
- ❖ Payment choices include Sign up for Automatic Draft Payments and your payment will be drafted from your checking or savings account each 6-month payment period. Download the ACH Draft Authorization
